Interpretation of Score

PILL-5 Score	Interpretation
0 to 5	Your score is within the normal range. If you still have concerns about swallowing pills, speak with your doctor or pharmacist.
6 to 11	Suggests pill swallowing is abnormal. Patients should discuss their results with their doctor. Alternative ways to take medication may be required that is easier to swallow.
>11	Suggests moderate to severe pill dysphagia. Patients should discuss their results with their doctor. An altered formulation of medication may be required that is easier to swallow.
